Physical Accessibility: Technical Specifications

Car Park

- The museum has a large car park, with two spaces reserved for people with disabilities, and can be reached via a road leading off Via Flaminia that runs alongside the museum grounds.
- Parking is free for visitors arriving by car with a disabled badge, subject to validation of the voucher at the ticket office or in the exhibition hall.
- The two reserved parking spaces are adjacent to the play area and are approximately 100 meters from the ticket office entrance and exit, with about half of this distance being on level, non-slip, flat ground.
- They are also approximately 70 metres from the pavilion entrance, via a route where the first 50 meters follow the same path leading to the ticket office (and are therefore level and on the same plane), whilst the remaining 20 meters are on level concrete;
- The surface of the car park area, at the reserved parking spaces, is level.

Structure and access routes

The museum comprises:

- 1 building on two levels connected by an internal staircase or two different external routes, housing the ticket office, bookshop, toilets, café and restaurant.
- 1 exhibition hall, also on two levels connected by a spiral ramp.

The automatic glass entrance door at Via Flaminia 82 is 160 centimeters wide and leads directly into the museum's ticket office.

The ticket office counter is 80 centimeters high.

next to the ticket office, a staircase of 9 steps leads to the bookshop, located on the second level of the building. The bookshop can also be accessed from the outside, at the rear of the building some 25 meters away, through a door preceded by a step.

From the hall, you can exit via:

- an automatic glass door, beyond which there is a ramp of 6 steps.
- a single-leaf manual door 110 centimeters wide, preceded by a ramp with two sections and a non-slip surface.
- the outdoor area connecting the building to the pavilion has cobblestone paving and is mostly sloping.

exiting through the ticket office door, preceded by the ramp, and walking alongside the building for approximately 20 meters (with a maximum gradient of around 10%), you reach the corner at the

rear of the building where, after a level area, the entrance to the bookshop is located (on the upper level of the building);

Continuing from the corner of the building towards the pavilion, after a further 10 meters you will encounter a ramp with 7 steps (over a total length of approximately 8.5 meters), which leads to the front of the pavilion entrance.

To avoid steps, you must walk alongside the hall building and then follow a path, which reaches a 12% gradient, to the pavilion area.

The total distance between the ticket office exit and the pavilion entrance is approximately 70 meters

(of which the last 20 meters or so are on level, concrete ground).

The play area

- the outdoor area running alongside the pavilion is used as a free play area: it is flat and the surface, which is level, consists of safety rubber in the play area and fixed gravel in the walkway leading to the car park. There is a play structure equipped with a sloping ramp.

The exhibition hall

- the hall is on two floors connected by a spiral ramp with a gradient of around 15% in some sections.
- the surface of the ramp is non-slip, and the ramp is fitted with landings that break up the sloping sections.
- access to the pavilion is via a manual glass door, 190 centimeters wide, which is opened by staff at the start of each shift.
- the counter in the pavilion is 83 centimeters high.
- the narrowest passageway within the entire pavilion is 90 centimeters wide.
- the two floors of the pavilion have no further internal level changes.
- games and installations on the ground floor, where situated on platforms, are fitted with metal ramps with a maximum gradient of 12%, complete with handrails and safety barriers.
